

**LIST SUBJECT TO CHANGE AT ANY TIME:**

The Steamboat Bike Park is intended for downhill mountain biking and consists of trails that contain naturally rugged terrain and man-made features. A downhill specific mountain bike is recommended when riding the Steamboat Bike Park. Equipment that cannot be loaded on the Lift safely will not be allowed up the lift equipment.

**EQUIPMENT RESTRICTIONS WITHIN BIKE PARK INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:** no kickstands, no kick-brakes, no wheels smaller than 16", no slick tread urban tires and must have a functional brake on each wheel.
