

## **ON-MOUNTAIN SUMMER DEVICES 2024**

List Subject to change at any time: The Steamboat Bike Park is intended for downhill mountain biking and consists of trails that contain naturally rugged terrain and manmade features. A downhill specific mountain bike is recommended when riding the Steamboat Bike Park. Equipment that cannot be loaded on the Lift safely will not be allowed up the lift equipment.

Equipment restrictions within Bike Park include but are not limited to: no kickstands, **no kick brakes**, **no wheels** smaller than 16", no slick tread urban tires and must have a functional brake on each wheel.
