List Subject to change at any time: *The Steamboat Bike Park is intended for downhill mountain biking and consists of trails that contain naturally rugged terrain and manmade features. A downhill specific mountain bike is recommended when riding the Steamboat Bike Park. Equipment that cannot be loaded on the Lift safely will not be allowed up the lift equipment.*

Equipment restrictions within Bike Park include but are not limited to: no kickstands, **no kick brakes, no wheels smaller than 16", no slick tread urban tires and must have a functional brake on each wheel.**
